## **Introduction**

Brecon Bible School is centred around the Word of our God. All brethren and sisters, young people and children are welcome to join in promoting warm fellowship in a spiritual family setting.

## **Venue**

Christ College is situated in the beautiful Brecon Beacons National Park, beside the River Usk and a short walk across the river bridge from the attractive county town of Brecon.

The College is easily accessible by main roads from both the M4 and M5 motorways.

We shall have full and exclusive use of the compact, self-contained site, which has comfortable accommodation and extensive facilities.

## **Accommodation**

The residential accommodation comprises five blocks with good boarding-school standard single, double and family rooms, some of which have integral wash-basin facility, and adequate numbers of bathrooms and showers which are adjoining or in close proximity.

Each house has comfortable lounges, kitchen areas and laundry facilities and most have additional showers and toilets on the ground floor.

Bed linen and all meals and drinks will be provided, but not towels.

The College has basic facilities for the disabled.

Please note that children's places are limited, so book early!

*Early booking is strongly advised.*

## **Campsite**

We use an excellent 5\* campsite, from where the views are truly wonderful and which is only about 4 minutes drive from the College.

Our caravans and tents can generally be pitched together for fellowship.

Some College facilities are available.

Refreshments are provided at the College as well as an evening meal on Monday and Friday. It is also possible to pre-book other meals.

## **Own accommodation**

If you prefer to day-visit or arrange your own accommodation off-site during the week, (camping, caravan or B & B) you will need to pay a day charge, which mostly comprises an amount charged by the college, and book and pay additionally for any meals required.

## **Daily programme**

This will include the daily readings and studies by the speakers in the morning and evening sessions.

The children and young people will have their own separate classes and programme.

The afternoons will be free for family fellowship with recreational activities and there will be optional additional studies and presentations during that time.

Supervised activities such as sport, walks and swimming in a newly renovated indoor pool will be arranged during free time. The College has full and excellent facilities including playing fields, cricket pitch, squash and tennis courts and a multi-sport gymnasium. The College has guest wi-fi available.

On Friday we shall all enjoy a family evening, including presentations by the teenagers and children. We hope to have a singing group again next year.

## **Other activities**

The Bible School Bookshop will be open at set times.

There will be an 'Activity' creche for toddlers, and a 'Quiet' creche area with sound relay from the main hall.
